The group flight cost is based on a minimum of 10 participants, not including those flying business class or taking the extension. The advantage of the group flight is that it gives us more time to pay for the flights until they become non-refundable. In the event that there are less than 10 members of the group flying together in economy class, flights will need to be ordered individually either directly or by Keshet, and the cost of the flight will be non-refundable.

Step 1 – Registration

Flight Cancellation/Changes Policy – International Group Flight

- ❖ Tickets can be either canceled entirely or changed with no fees until **December 1, 2024.**
- ❖ Cancellation and or changes to air reservation beginning **December 1, 2024** will incur a partial cancellation fee as reflected in the refund schedule on this document
- ❖ Changes to individual or the group air reservations beginning **January 3, 2025** will incur significant penalties, possibly up to **the entire cost of the ticket**
- ❖ Cancellation of individual or the group air reservations beginning **January 3, 2025** will forfeit **the entire cost of the ticket** as reflected in the refund schedule on this document
